# Paese storico della Ciociaria: BOVILLE ERNICA

Adagiata su un ripido colle, Boville Ernica, popolazione 8879 a 487 s.l.m. e a 16 Km. est da Frosinone, domina le valli del Liri, del Cosa e del Sacco. La sua storia affonda le radici nell'epoca preromana (gli Ernici, infatti, era uno dei tanti popoli che abitavano in questa parte dell'Italia, molto prima dell'esistenza di Roma), come attestano i numerosi rinvenimenti archeologici e le sue mura pelasgiche su Colle Fico. Il suo primitivo nome di "Bauco" ricorda il culto agricolo del dio Bove, simbolo della fecondità. Nella zona archeologica di monte Fico, dove sorgeva il tempio dedicato a questa divinità, sono state ritrovate statuette votive raffiguranti il bue. Boville Ernica un tempo sorgeva al piano, ma dopo le invasioni dei Saraceni e degli Ungari (X sec.), vide la sua popolazione trasferirsi sul colle e divenne uno dei centri più fortificati: oltre le citate mura pelasgiche, la rendevano imprendibile il grandioso castello e la possente cinta muraria medioevale con ben 18 torri (alternate tonde e quadrate) ancor'oggi totalmente in piedi. Il patrimonio monumentale e artistico di Boville è costituito inoltre dai palazzi rinascimentali delle famiglie gentilizie e dalle sue chiese. Tra queste ricordiamo S. Pietro Ispano edificata nel XII sec. sulla stessa grotta nella quale, per lunghi anni, visse penitente il Santo Patrono. In esso si conservano un sarcofago paleocristiano, due reliquiari del Santo e di S. Lucia, la cappella gentilizia Simoncelli, un bassorilievo del Sansovino e, eccezionalissimo, un mosaico di Giotto. Si potrebbe scrivere per giorni per esaltare tutta la famosa e lunga storia, la geografia e tante altre cose di Boville, ma purtroppo la mancanza di spazio non ce lo permette.

Laid out over the summit of a steep hill, Boville Ernica – pop. 8879 inhabitants, at 487 m. a.s.l. and 16 Km. east of Frosinone – dominates the splendour of the Liri, Cosa and Sacco Valleys. The town's history stretches back to a remote pre-Roman epoch, which is testified by its numerous archeological findings and prehistoric Pelasgic walls. The "Ernici" were, in fact, one of the many peoples, who inhabited this area of Italy, much before Rome came into existence. Boville's primordial name "Bauco" recalls the ancient agricultural worship of the god Bove (bull), symbol of fertility. In the archeological area of Monte Fico, where once stood a temple dedicated to this divinity, there have come to light votive statuettes featuring bulls. Boville Ernica was once situated



on the plains below its present site, but after the Saracen and Hungarian invasions (10th cent.), its population moved to the higher levels of Monte Fico, where the ancient center was transformed into one of the most fortified towns in the region. In addition to the mentioned Pelasgic walls there is to be seen the imposing castle and its powerful belts of Medieval walls having as many as 18 turrets and towers (alternating as round and square shapes); all still standing completely intact. The monumental and artistic heritage of Boville includes many Renaissance palaces and churches. Among them, comes to the fore S. Pietro Ispano, erected in the 12th century over the actual grotto, in which for many years lived penitent the Patron Saint. The church still conserves an early-Christian sarcophagus, two reliquaries, belonging to S. Pietro Ispano and S. Lucia, a chapel once belonging to the noble family of the Simoncelli, a Sansovino bas relief and an exceptional mosaic attributed to Giotto. Much more could be written about the long and interesting history, geography and many other things about Boville Ernica, but our limited space prevents us to do so.



## Ennio Filonardi

Il Cardinale ENNIO FILONARDI (nato: Boville Ernica 1446; morto: Roma, Castel S. Angelo 1549) fu un personaggio molto stimato presso la Santa Sede e grazie alle sue doti di diplomatico, amministratore, umanista, godette la fiducia di sette papi, da Innocenzo VII a Paolo III. Le sue vicende si legarono a quelle delle famiglie Farnese, Colonna, Borgia.

Fu vescovo di Veroli per più di mezzo secolo, Abate commendatario dell' Abbazia di Casamari, governatore di Bologna, governatore di Imola, governatore di Castel S. Angelo (l' equivalente del Ministro della Guerra dello Stato Pontificio), Vescovo di Montefeltro in Romagna, governatore della provincia di Campagna e Marittima, Governatore di Camerino, Parma, Piacenza, Nunzio Apostolico in Svizzera.

Fu proprio in questa veste che riuscì a salvare e staccare parte della Svizzera dalla Riforma Protestante entrando in contatto con Erasmo da Notterdam, Zuinglio, Melantone. Fu amico, di numerosi artisti tra cui l'inquieto orafo Benvenuto Cellini, al quale commissionò il busto argenteo di S. Pietro Ispano. A Boville rimangono molti edifici fatti costruire dal cardinale: il Catello, la cappella di S. Sebastiano, annessa alla chiesa di S. Michele Arcangelo, la chiesa della Madonna delle Grazie (extra moenia). A lui si deve anche il palazzo vescovile di Veroli. Morì a Roma proprio mentre era in corso il conclave che, pare, l'avrebbe eletto papa. La sua tomba è nella chiesa di S. Michele Arcangelo in Boville.

**ENNIO FILONARDI**, Cardinal, was born in Boville Ernica in 1446 and died in Castel Sant'Angelo in Rome, in 1549. He was highly esteemed in the Holy See and thanks to his personal talents, he enjoyed the trust of seven popes, from Innocenzo VII to Paolo III. His accomplishments were tied to the Farnese, Colonna and Borgia families. He was Bishop of Veroli for almost half a century, commentator Abbot in the Abbey of Casamari and Governor of Bologna, Imola, Castel Sant'Angelo, the provinces of Campagna and Marittima, of Camerino, Parma, Piacenza and Bishop of Montefeltro in Romagna and Apostolic Nuncio in Switzerland. It was while in this charge that he was able to save and separate part of Switzerland from the Protestant Reform. There are still many structures in Boville that were built by the Cardinal: the Castle, the chapel of St. Sebastiano (now part of the St. Michele Arcangelo church), the church of the Madonna delle Grazie and the Bishop's building in Veroli. He died in Rome while the papal elections were being held. It is said that had he lived through it, he would have been elected pope. His remains are found in the church of St. Michele Arcangelo in Boville Ernica.

## CHEF'S CORNER:

### Maritzozzi

#### INGREDIENTS

6 eggs  
2 cups of sugar  
1 cup of oil  
1/2 cup Anisette liquor  
Dried raisins  
Live yeast or 1 envelope dry yeast  
Flour as much as needed to make a soft yeast dough

Egg wash  
2 egg yolks, beaten

Yield: approx. 36 buns

#### DIRECTIONS:

- Mix ingredients and work into a soft malleable dough (softer than regular bread dough).
- Shape the dough into a ball and place in a container. Let rise to double in volume.
- Take the dough and cut a chunk of dough, about as much to make a meatball.
- On a wooden board, shape the dough into taralli style log, 14 inches long, 1/2 inch thick.
- On a cookie sheet lined with parchment paper, shape the log into a swirled bun by first making a largish circle with part of the dough and swirling the rest around like the soft ice cream at Dairy Queen.
- Brush the maritzozzi with the egg yolk.
- Keep the maritzozzi on the table to rest and increase in volume a little.
- Preheat oven to 325 degrees F.
- After the second rise, bake on middle rack until golden brown.
