
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Paese storico della Ciociaria: AUSONIA

Ausonia e' una cittadina panoramica che sorge tra i monti Aurunci ed e' attraversata dalla strada regionale SR630 Cassino-Formia. Circondata da splendidi uliveti, le sue case sono di pietra grigia, i suoi orti e giardini sono terrazzamenti costruiti con muri a secco. Con il suo antico nome "Castrum Fractae" compare tra i possedimenti dell'Abbazia di Montecassino. Solo nel 1862, dopo l'unità d'Italia, divenne Ausonia. Interessanti e numerosi sono i suoi monumenti. Tra essi ricordiamo la Collegiata di S.Michele Arcangelo, sorta sui resti di età romanica, con facciata romanica e tre portali di stile gotico; da notare presso l'entrata le due acquasantiere ricavate da are votive romane. Il Castello, donato nel 1065 a Montecassino dai principi di Capua, è costruzione militare ma anche residenziale. In pietra viva è costruita S. Maria a Castello con l'elegante campanile. Il Santuario di Santa Maria del Piano è notevole per gli affreschi dell'XI secolo, custoditi nella cripta, che illustrano la storia del miracolo di S. Remicarda e per il polittico di G. B. Criscuolo. Ma soprattutto interessanti sono i passaggi coperti, le scalinate, le strette vie e piazzette su cui si affacciano palazzi settecenteschi, con bei portali e suggestive bifore dalle cornici catalane. E tutto questo dà un senso di quiete e di pacata austerità.

Abitanti: 2590; altitudine: m. 178 s.l.m.; localita': 35 km. a sud-est di Frosinone; piatti tipici, come nel resto della maggioranza della Ciociaria.

Ausonia is beautifully set among the Aurunci Mountains and it's crossed by the Regional Road 630 (SR630) Cassino-Formia. Surrounded by olive groves, its houses are made of gray stone, its orchards and gardens are terraces built with dry stone walls. With its ancient name "Castrum Fractae" it was among the possessions of the Abbey of Montecassino. Only in 1862, after the unification of Italy, it became Ausonia . Interesting are its numerous monuments. Among these are the Collegiate Church



of St. Michael the Archangel, built on the remains of the Romanesque period, with a Romanesque façade and three portals in Gothic style; note at the entrance the two holy water fonts which are derived from Roman votives. The Castle, donated in 1065 to Montecassino by the princes of Capua, is of military construction but also residential. In living stone is built St. Mary in the Castle with the elegant bell tower. The Sanctuary of Santa Maria del Piano is notable for the frescoes of the eleventh century, preserved in the crypt, which illustrate the story of the miracle of St. Remicarda and for the polyptych of G. B. Criscuolo. But most interesting sights of all are the cloisters, the covered passageways, staircases, narrow streets and small squares overlooked by eighteenth century buildings, with beautiful doors and mullioned windows suggestive of Catalan frames. All of this gives a sense of peace and quiet austerity.

Population: 2590; altitude: m. 178 a.s.l.; distance from Frosinone: km. 35 (SW). Typical dishes: as in the rest of most of Ciociaria




BATTLE OF THE BRAINS





Libero De Libero

LIBERO DE LIBERO - Fondi, 10-09-1903; Roma, 04-07-1981

Gli anni formativi di Libero De Libero, furono quelli degli studi classici, da lui compiuti nella sua amata Valle Latina tra Ferentino e Alatri, con la guida di ottimi docenti, uno dei quali lo introdusse alla poesia di Dante, Leopardi, Baudelaire, i grandi poeti che lo «ubriacarono». Furono gli anni delle letture sistematiche e della vita di provincia, che resterà tra le memorie nostalgiche del poeta: «Al suo ambiente solitario, ricco di pollini segreti e di quotidiane visioni, io



debbo un'eccezionale vicenda di sentimenti e di pensieri che m'hanno aiutato a diventare uomo.» Si laurea in Giurisprudenza a Roma. Nel 1928 fonda il quindicinale "Interplanetario"; vi collaborano Corrado Alvaro, Massimo Bontempelli e Alberto Moravia. La sua prima attività poetica si colloca nell'ambito dell'ermetismo. La prima raccolta, "Solstizio", è pubblicata da Ungaretti sulle pagine di Novissima, altre raccolte sono Proverbi (1937), Testa (1938), Eclisse (1940). Anche dopo la guerra la produzione di poeta, narratore e saggista (culminata nei saggi Mafai, 1949; I volti di Masaccio, 1956; Maccari, 1976), è di vasto respiro. Numerosi i suoi contributi volti a chiarire aspetti e problemi del tempo della Scuola romana, di cui è fra i protagonisti in campo letterario, a contatto con i maggiori avvenimenti artistici del tempo. Ha lasciato interessanti memorie della "terza saletta" del Caffè Aragno, di cui era assiduo frequentatore. E' tra gli estimatori del gruppo di Via Cavour (con Ungaretti, Sinigalli, Falqui). Dal 1935 al 1938, De Libero dirige la Galleria della Cometa, in veste di direttore artistico. Con Enrico Falqui cura, dal 1940 al 1942, l'almanacco di "Beltempo" per le Edizioni della Cometa (che fonda e dirige), nelle cui collane appaiono tra l'altro libri di Bontempelli (Introduzione all'Apocalisse), Savinio (Tragedia dell'infanzia), Beccarla (Adamo). Nel 1981 appare un interessante libro di memorie dal titolo Roma 1935. Egli non interruppe mai i rapporti artistici con la Ciociaria, terra d'origine ed ispiratrice delle sue composizioni, frequentando artisti ed intellettuali nel capoluogo ciociaro, soliti incontrarsi presso la galleria "La Saletta".

The educational years of Libero De Libero where those during his classical studies, which he attended in his beloved Valle Latina, found between Ferentino and Alatri, just near Frosinone. He was blessed with the guidance of excellent academics, one of which introduced him to Dante, Leopardi and Baudelaire, the big names who greatly influenced him into poetry. He, himself declared that it was in this part of Ciociaria that he became a mature man. De Libero graduated in Law in Rome. In 1928 he founded the fortnightly "Interplanetary", in which Corrado Alvaro, Bontempelli and Alberto Moravia collaborated. His first poetic work is part of Hermeticism. The first collection, "Solstice", is published by Ungaretti on the pages of 'Novissima'. Other collections are Proverbs (1937), Head (1938), Eclipse (1940). Even after the war the production of poet, novelist and essayist (culminated in Mafai essays, 1949; The faces of Masaccio, 1956; Maccari, 1976), is of expansive scale. Many are his contributions to clarify aspects and problems of the times of the Roman School, of which he is one of the protagonists in literature, in contact with the major artistic events of the time. He left interesting memories of the "third little room" of the Caffè Aragno, of which he was a frequent visitor. He is among the fans of the group of Via Cavour (Ungaretti, Sinigalli, Falqui). From 1935 to 1938, De Libero directed the Galleria della Cometa, as artistic director. With Henry Falqui he cared, from 1940 to 1942, for the almanac of "Beltempo" for the Editions of the Comet (which he founded and directed), in whose series appear among others, books of Bontempelli (Introduction to the Apocalypse), Savinio (Childhood Tragedy) and Beccarla (Adam). In 1981, he published an interesting memoir titled Rome 1935. He never interrupted his artistic connections with Ciociaria, his region of origin and inspiring of his many compositions, mingling with artists and intellectuals in the Provincial Capital, usually meeting in the gallery "La Saletta). CHEF'S CORNER

GOURMET MUSHROOM RISOTTO

Ingredients:

6 cups chicken broth, divided 3 tablespoons olive oil, divided 1 pound portobello mushrooms, thinly

1 pound white mushrooms, thinly sliced 2 shallots, diced

1 1/2 cups Arborio rice 1/2 cup dry white wine sea salt to taste freshly ground black pepper to taste 3 tablespoons finely chopped chives

Directions:

In a saucepan, warm the broth over low heat. Warm 2 tablespoons olive oil in a large skillet over medium-high heat. Stir in the mushrooms and cook until soft, about 3 minutes. mushrooms and their liquid and set aside.

1/2 cup freshly grated parmesan cheese

Add 1 tablespoon olive oil to skillet and stir in the 2 diced shallots. Cook 1 minute. Add rice stirring to coat with oil, about 2 minutes. When the rice has taken on a pale colour, pour in the wine, stirring constantly until wine is fully absorbed, Add 1/2 cup broth to the rice and stir until broth is absorbed. Continue adding broth 1/2 cup at a time, stirring continuously, until the liquid is absorbed and the rice is "al dente", about 15 to 20 minutes.

Remove from heat, and stir in the mushrooms with their liquid, the butter, the 3 tblsps of chives and the parmesan. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Enjoy!!
