





STUDENT BURSARY APPLICATION

1. AMOUNT

Eight bursaries in the amount of \$1000.00 each are available in each year that there is at least one candidate that satisfies the eligibility criteria. The Ciociaro Club reserves the right to award more bursaries if feasible and/or if the Ciociaro Club obtains sponsors for same.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The Applicant must be:

- a) A member in good standing of the Ciociaro Club for a minimum of one year (a Junior member is sufficient, but a Social member is not);
- b) A Full-Time secondary school student who has applied to be enrolled as a first year student at a recognized University or Community College OR a student already enrolled in a Full-Time program at a recognized University or Community College.
- c) 23 years old or younger at the time of application.
- d) Students can only apply for the Bursary once even if they are not a successful recipient.

3. SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants will be evaluated by the Ciociaro Club Bursary Committee with emphasis given to academic excellence; additional consideration will be given to community involvement, involvement with the Ciociaro Club and financial need. For one of the bursaries, financial need will be the primary consideration.

4. AWARDING BURSARIES

Awarding of bursaries is contingent upon confirmation by the Bursary Committee of the Applicant's attendance at a Post-Secondary Institution.

5. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The Applicant must be:

- a) A resume including a completed Application;
- b) An official transcript of grades from the student's most recent year of study;
- c) A plan of study;
- d) A statement describing the Applicant's community involvement and involvement with the Ciociaro Club;

- e) A 500-word maximum essay outlining the Applicant's educational goals;
- f) Information confirming the Applicant's financial need, should the Applicant wish this criterion to be considered, and/or should the Applicant wish to be considered for the bursary in which financial need is the primary consideration; and
- g) Any other information which the Applicant may wish the Bursary Committee to consider or which the Bursary Committee may require.

The Ciociaro Club Bursary Committee reserves the right to ask for verification of any information submitted and to interview Applicants and their references whenever it is deemed necessary by the Bursary Committee.

All information submitted to the Bursary Committee will be kept in the strictest confidence. Please note that, upon submission of a bursary application to the Ciociaro Club office, the Applicant will be assigned a pseudonym by the Ciociaro Club's office staff, and the pseudonym is the only name which will appear on the Application when it is reviewed and considered by the Bursary Committee. All names, addresses and similar information which may reveal the identity of the Applicant will be blacked out on the copy of the Application reviewed and considered by the Bursary Committee. Accordingly, the review of Applications by the Bursary Committee will be "blind", in that the members of the Bursary Committee will not know the identities of the Applicants at the time that the Applications are reviewed and considered.

2025 CIOCIARO CLUB CONSTITUTION

The By-Law amendments below were presented and approved by the Board of Directors on October 23, 2025. These By-Law amendments will be presented at the General Assembly meeting on Sunday November 30, 2025, for approval by the General Assembly.

Amendment #1	PROPOSED Amendment to the current Election By-Law III, Section III:
Reason	To protect the Club election committee process from conduct of bias, conflict of interest, inappropriate behaviours, and defamation by a Club member. The Club constitution needs to protect the fairness and transparency of the election process.
Add	The Chief Election Officer has the authority to remove any member of the Election Committee or Scrutineer for reasons including, but not limited to; bias, conflict of interest, inappropriate behaviours, or defamation.
Add	The Chief Election Officer shall prepare and submit a written report to the President noting the name, date, and description of the inappropriate conduct of the Election Committee member or Scrutineer within 48 hours of the decision.

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CASALATTICO

Casalattico, 60 km. from (province of) Frosinone; pop., 705; alt., 420 m. a.s.l.; in the Comino Valley . It took its name from the illustrious citizen Pomponius Atticus, brother-in-law of Cicero, who owned a villa in what is now Montattico. In Roman times, this territory belonged to the Pomponia clan, and in 1305 its name became Casale Attico. Today,



the town is divided into two parts: the lower part, which encompasses the old town with narrow, irregular streets, and the upper part, which is decidedly more modern in appearance. Casalattico has experienced a significant emigration, and today, those who were forced to leave still return during the summer. Among the most famous and fortunate emigrants from this land is Carmine Forte, known as Charles, who emigrated to Great Britain and became the owner of a world-famous chain of hotels and restaurants, and was awarded the title of baronet by Queen Elizabeth. In the village, the parish church is worth a visit, which houses several valuable paintings by Polish artist Taddeo Kuntz and the Neapolitan School of Santafede, 16th-century artists who had their workshops here. A few kilometers from the center, the hamlet of Montattico is a starting point for scenic hiking trails in the Obachelle and Marro mountain ranges. The town is twinned with Naas (Ireland). Casalattico, a 60 km. da Frosinone; Abit., 705 circa; alt., 420 m. s.l.m.; nella Valle di Comino. Prese il nome dall'illustre cittadino Pomponio Attico, cognato di Cicerone, che possedeva una villa nell'attuale Montattico. In epoca romana, questo territorio apparteneva al clan Pomponia e nel 1305 il suo nome divenne Casale Attico. Oggi il paese è diviso in due parti: la parte bassa, che racchiude il centro storico con strade strette e irregolari, e la parte alta, dall'aspetto decisamente più moderno. Casalattico ha vissuto una significativa emigrazione e ancora oggi, coloro che sono stati costretti ad andarsene, tornano durante l'estate.

Tra gli emigranti più famosi e fortunati di questa terra c'è Carmine Forte, detto Charles, che emigrò in Gran Bretagna e divenne proprietario di una catena di alberghi e ristoranti di fama mondiale, e fu insignito del titolo di baronetto dalla regina Elisabetta. Nel paese, merita una visita la chiesa parrocchiale, che custodisce pregevoli dipinti del polacco Taddeo Kuntz e della scuola napoletana

dei Santafede, artisti del XVI secolo che qui avevano le loro botteghe. A pochi chilometri dal centro, la frazione di Montattico è punto di partenza per suggestivi sentieri escursionistici nei gruppi montuosi dell'Obachelle e del Marro. Il comune è gemellato con Naas (Irlanda). Piatti tipici: gli "abbuoti" (involtini d'abbacchio con regaglie, cucinato arrosto); sagne e fagioli con cannellini nostrani.

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Charles Carmine Forte - Baron Forte - Casalattico, Frosinone, 26 November 1908 - London 28 February 2007, was an Italian-born Scottish hotelier who founded the leisure and hotels conglomerate that ultimately became the Forte Group. Charles Forte was born as Carmine Forte in Mortale, now Monforte, Casalattico, in the province of Frosinone, eldest son of Rocco Giovanni Forte and Maria Luigia. He emigrated from Italy to Scotland at the age of four with his family. He attended Alloa Academy and then St. Joseph's College, Dumfries, as a boarder, followed by two years of studies in Rome. After

Rome, Forte rejoined his family, who had moved to Weston-super-Mare, where his father ran a café with two cousins. Charles' main training at the age of 21 came in Brighton, where he managed the "Venetian". At 26, he set up his "the Strand Milk Bar Ltd." in 1935. Soon he began expanding into catering and hotel businesses. At the outbreak of World War II, Forte was interned in the Isle of Man due to his Italian nationality, but he was released after only three months. After the war, his company became Forte Holdings Ltd. and bought the Café Royal in 1954. In the 1950s, he also opened the first catering facility at Heathrow Airport and the first full motorway service station in the UK for cars at Newport Pagnell, Buckinghamshire, on the M1 motorway in 1959. He purchased the Hungaria Restaurant in Lower Regent St. in 1955. Trust Houses Group Ltd. and Forte Holdings were merged in 1970 to become Trust House Forte. Through mergers and expansion, Forte expanded the Forte Group into a multibillion-pound business. His empire included the Little Chef and Happy Eater roadside restaurants, Crest, Forte Grand, Travelodge and Posthouse hotels, as well as the wine merchant Grierson-Blumenthal and a non-controlling majority stake in the Savoy Hotel. Forte was the CEO from 1971 and chairman from 1982 (when his son Rocco took over as CEO) of the Group. Lord Forte passed full control to his son Rocco in 1993, but soon the plc was faced with a hostile takeover bid from Granada. Ultimately, Granada succeeded with a £3.9 billion tender offer in January 1996, which left the family with about £350 million in cash. He is buried in West Hampstead Cemetery. Honours and awards: Forte was knighted by The Queen Mother in 1970 and created a life peer on 2 February 1982, as Baron Forte of Ripley, in the County of Surrey. He was also a knight of the Sovereign Military Order of Malta.

Charles Carmine Forte - Barone Forte - Casalattico, Frosinone, 26 novembre 1908 - Londra, 28 febbraio 2007, è stato un alberghiere scozzese di origine italiana, fondatore del conglomerato alberghiero e attività ricreative che in seguito sarebbero diventate il Forte Group. Charles Forte, nato Carmine Forte a Mortale, oggi Monforte, Casalattico, in provincia di Frosinone, figlio maggiore di Rocco Giovanni Forte e Maria Luigia. Emigrò dall'Italia in Scozia all'età di quattro anni con la sua famiglia. Frequentò l'Alloa Academy e poi il St. Joseph's College di Dumfries come convittore, seguito da due anni di studi a Roma. Dopo Roma, Forte si

riunì alla sua famiglia, che si era trasferita a Weston-super-Mare, dove suo padre gestiva un caffè con due cugini. La formazione principale di Charles, all'età di 21 anni, avvenne a Brighton, dove gestì il "Venetian". A 26 anni, fondò il suo "The Strand Milk Bar Ltd." nel 1935. Ben presto iniziò a espandersi nel settore della ristorazione e dell'ospitalità alberghiera. Allo scoppio della Seconda Guerra Mondiale, Forte fu internato nell'Isola di Man a causa della sua nazionalità italiana, ma fu rilasciato dopo soli tre mesi. Dopo la guerra, la sua azienda divenne Forte Holdings Ltd. e acquistò il Café Royal nel 1954. Negli anni '50, aprì anche il primo servizio di ristorazione all'aeroporto di Heathrow e la prima area di servizio autostradale completa per auto nel Regno Unito a Newport Pagnell, nel Buckinghamshire, sull'autostrada M1 nel 1959. Acquistò l'Hungaria Restaurant in Lower Regent St. nel 1955. Trust Houses Group Ltd. e Forte Holdings si fusero nel 1970 per dare vita a Trust House Forte. Attraverso fusioni ed espansioni, Forte trasformò il Forte Group in un'azienda multimiliardaria. Il suo impero comprendeva i ristoranti Little Chef e Happy Eater, gli hotel Crest, Forte Grand, Travelodge e Posthouse, nonché l'enoteca Grierson-Blumenthal e una quota di maggioranza non di controllo del Savoy Hotel. Forte fu CEO dal 1971 e presidente dal 1982 (quando suo figlio Rocco assunse la carica di CEO) del Gruppo. Lord Forte cedette il pieno controllo al figlio Rocco nel 1993, ma ben presto la società per azioni si trovò ad affrontare un'offerta pubblica di acquisto ostile da parte di Granada. Alla fine, Granada vinse con un'offerta pubblica di acquisto da 3,9 miliardi di sterline nel gennaio 1996, che lasciò alla famiglia circa 350 milioni di sterline in contanti. Egli è sepolto nel cimitero di West Hampstead. Onorificenze e premi: Forte fu nominato cavaliere dalla Regina Madre nel 1970 e nominato pari a vita il 2 febbraio 1982, come Barone Forte di Ripley, nella Contea del Surrey. Fu anche cavaliere del Sovrano Militare Ordine di Malta.
