SORA

Splendita cittadina, è uno dei maggiori centri della provincia di Frosinone. Attraversata dal fiume Liri, sorge nel punto d'incontro delle tre valli; del Liri, di Roveto e di Comino, sviluppandosi interamente in pianura. Fondata dai Volsci, sebbene in precedenza il suo territorio fosse abitato da altre genti italiche, venne in seguito assoggettata a Roma. Fu a lungo capitale del Gastaldato longobardo, poi dominio dei Normanni.

Dichiarata "città regia" dal re di Napoli Carlo I Angiò nel XIV secolo, in seguito divenne feudo dei Tomacelli, dei Cantelmi, dei Della Rovere e dei Boncompagni.

Tra la fine del Settecento e l'inizio dell'Ottocento divenne teatro di feroci episodi di brigantaggio, tra occupazioni militari borboniche, sanfediste e francesi. Molti e importanti i luoghi di culto della cittadina che potrebbero far parte di un vero e proprio itinerario religioso. Citiamo tra le tante la Cattedrale, sede vescovile, l'Abbazia di San Domenico, Santa Restituta con il portale trecentesco, il Convento dei Padri Passionisti, ecc.

Tra le vestigia del suo passato ricordiamo il Santuario rupestre del Dio Silvano (sec II d.C.), le mura poligonali e i resti del Castello di San Casto (sec. XI), posto sull'omonimo monte si raggiunge a piedi. Lungo il percorso è possibile godere di ampie vedute sull'intera città. Ma una delle testimonianze più antiche ed importanti di Sora è il Ponte Marmone (sec I a.C.); non distante dall'Abbazia di San Domenico vi sono i suoi resti, infatti fu quasi interamente distrutto da Federico II nel 1229.

La Sora moderna si presenta come importante centro commerciale, fulcro di un vasto ed importante comprensorio. Abitanti: circa 25000; Altitudine: 300m. s. l. m.; Piatti iconici includono: Sagne e Faciuri, piatti a base di guanciale, pecorino, legumi e dolci locali, e le famose ciammelle sorane.

A beautiful small city, Sora is one of the major centers in the province of Frosinone. Crossed by the Liri River, it lies at the meeting point of the three valleys, Liri, Roveto, and Comino, extending entirely on the plain. Founded by the Volscians, although its territory was previously inhabited by other Italic peoples, it was later subjugated to Rome. It was long the capital of the Lombard Gastaldato, then a Norman dominion.



Declared a "royal city" by the King of Naples, Charles I Anjou, in the 14th century, it later became a fiefdom of the Tomacelli, Cantelmi, Della Rovere, and Boncompagni families. Between the late 18th and early 19th centuries, it became the scene of ferocious episodes of brigandage, amidst military occupation by the Bourbons, Sanfedisti, and French. The town's many

important places of worship could be part of a true religious itinerary.

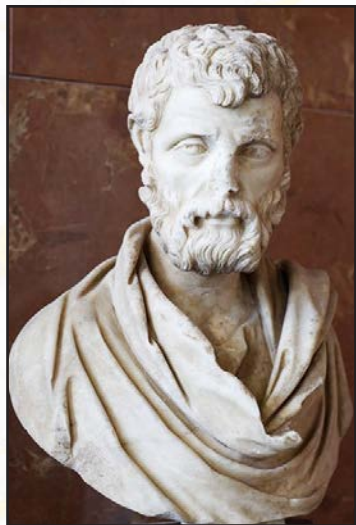
Among them are the Cathedral, the bishop's seat, the Abbey of San Domenico, Santa Restituta with its 14th-century portal, the Convent of the Passionist Fathers, and more.

Among the vestiges of its past are the rock sanctuary of the god Silvano (2nd century AD), the polygonal walls, and the remains of the Castle of San Casto (11th century). Located on the mountain of the same name, it can be reached on foot. Along the way, you can enjoy sweeping views of the entire city. But one of Sora's oldest and most important remains is the Marmone Bridge (1st century BC). Its remains are not far from the Abbey of San Domenico, although it was almost entirely destroyed by Frederick II in 1229.

POPULATION: ABOUT 25000; Altitude: 300M. A.S.L.; SPECIAL DISHES: Sagne and Beans, Hog Jowl-based dishes, Pecorino cheese and famous Ciambelle Sorane - a form of doughnut-shaped semi-sweet bread, other sweets.

MARCO ATTILIO REGOLO



Marco Atilio Regolo (Sora, circa 299 a.C. – Cartagine, 246 a.C.) è stato un celebre console e generale romano, simbolo di eroismo, patriottismo e integrità morale (fides) durante la prima guerra punica.

Carriera e Punti Chiave:

Doppio Consolato: Fu eletto console due volte: nel 267 a.C., quando sconfisse i Salentini e conquistò Brindisi, e nel 256 a.C. durante la prima guerra punica.

Spedizione in Africa: Nel 256 a.C., dopo aver sconfitto la flotta cartaginese a Capo Ecnomo, sbarcò in Africa, portando la guerra nel territorio nemico e ottenendo importanti vittorie.

Cattività e Leggenda: Sconfitto dal generale spartano Santippo, fu preso prigioniero. Secondo la tradizione storiografica romana, fu inviato a Roma dai Cartaginesi per negoziare la pace o uno scambio di prigionieri, giurando di tornare se non avesse avuto successo.

Onore fino alla Morte: Giunto a Roma, dissuase il Senato dall'accettare le proposte cartaginesi, esortando a continuare la guerra. Fedele alla sua parola, tornò a Cartagine. La leggenda narra che i Cartaginesi lo torturarono ferocemente fino alla morte.

La figura di Regolo è celebrata come esempio massimo del dovere e della virtù romana (mores maiorum), descritta da autori classici come Orazio e Seneca.

ORGANIZZATO DA ERMINIO DI DOMENICO

Marcus Atilius Regulus (Sora, c. 299 BC – Carthage, 246 BC) was a famous Roman consul and general, a symbol of heroism, patriotism, and moral integrity (fides) during the First Punic War.

Career and Key Points:

Double Consulate: He was elected consul twice: in 267 BC, when he defeated the Salentines and conquered Brindisi, and in 256 BC during the First Punic War.

Career and Key Points:

Double Consulate: He was elected consul twice: in 267 BC, when he defeated the Salentines and conquered Brindisi, and in 256 BC during the First Punic War.

Expedition to Africa: In 256 BC, after defeating the Carthaginian fleet at Cape Ecnomus, he landed in Africa, carrying the war into enemy territory and achieving important victories.

Captivity and Legend: Defeated by the Spartan general Xanthippus, he was taken prisoner. According to Roman historiographical tradition, he was sent to Rome by the Carthaginians to negotiate peace or a prisoner exchange, vowing to return if unsuccessful.

Honor until Death: Upon arriving in Rome, he dissuaded the Senate from accepting the Carthaginian proposals, urging them to continue the war. True to his word, he returned to Carthage. Legend has it that the Carthaginians savagely tortured him to death.

Regulus is celebrated as the supreme example of Roman duty and virtue (mores maiorum), described by classical authors such as Horace and Seneca.
